The CASI Elvie L. Smith Award is presented in recognition and honour of the outstanding and unique contributions made by Elvie L. Smith to the Canadian Aeronautics and Space Institute and to Canada's aerospace industry as a whole. A long-time Fellow of the Institute, Mr. Smith was the recipient of the CASI McCurdy Award, the Institute's top honour in scientific and engineering areas of activity, and of the CASI C.D. Howe Award for outstanding management leadership in aeronautics. Mr. Smith, a former President and Chairman of Pratt & Whitney Canada, provided lasting benefits to Canadian aviation through his vision, dedication and leadership in the design, development and manufacture of gas turbine engines, in both the technical and managerial areas.

In recognition of these contributions the CASI Elvie L. Smith Award is presented annually to a student who is following a post-secondary degree or diploma course recognized by the Institute as a qualifying step towards Member status in CASI.

To be eligible for the CASI Elvie L. Smith Award, the applicant must be in the last year of undergraduate studies in January of the year he or she applies for the scholarship, be a Canadian citizen, and be a student member in good standing of CASI.

The Award is accompanied by a bursary of \$5,000 as determined each year by Pratt & Whitney Canada, sponsor of the Award.
