



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING between Students for the Exploration and Development of Space Canada and Canadian Aeronautics and Space Institute

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) expresses the general desire of the parties to promote each other's interests and activities.

The Canadian Aeronautics & Space Institute (CASI) was founded in 1954. Its mission is to provide opportunities for learning, collaboration, networking, and professional development for those in or aspiring to join the Canadian aerospace community.

SEDS-Canada – Students for the Exploration and Development of Space Canada – was refounded in 2014. It is a national student-led non-profit dedicated to supporting students in the space sector, creating meaningful opportunities for them to get hands on experience, fostering growth in the Canadian space sector, and promoting public interest in space.

To better serve the common interests and welfare of their respective memberships, CASI and SEDS-Canada agree:

- 1. To continuously seek and collaborate on ways in which information can be exchanged between both organizations.
- 2. To cross-promote CASI and SEDS-Canada activities in newsletters and other communication tools such as websites and social media.
- 3. To encourage cross-attendance or joint participation in events sponsored or hosted by either organization. Typical events include lectures and Branch meetings, social activities and other gatherings.
- 4. To explore opportunities for collaboration on the organization of conferences and workshops.

This MOU renews from year to year unless either party gives notice of intent to terminate the agreement, such notice maybe signalled by either party, for any reason, upon 30 days written notice.
