



CASI Quebec Scholarship Application

The **CASI Québec Scholarship** will be awarded this year to two outstanding students who are pursuing an engineering undergraduate degree in a university in Quebec.

To be eligible, the student must:

- Have completed at least 2 years' worth of credits (60 Credits, excluding freshman credits) at the date of application.
- Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident.
- Be a student member in good standing with CASI (for the 1st Rank) or any other engineering institute (for the 2nd Rank).
- Display a keen interest in Aerospace.

The first rank has a monetary value of 650 CAD and is reserved for CASI Quebec and CASI Concordia Members. The second rank has a monetary value of 350 CAD. For this rank, if the selected student is not a CASI Member, a CASI Quebec Junior Membership will be offered and the fees (35\$ + Tax) will be subtracted from the scholarship value.
